

Students without High School Diploma

The first thing you need to do is to obtain a High School diploma from us. This diploma is equivalent, for us, to the Tunisian Bac. This is an independent program and it has its own tuition, not in any way, related to Broward College studies.

How to obtain a High School diploma?

You need to enroll in our High School diploma program and take and pass at least 5 courses in order to obtain our High School diploma. This program is 4 month long and it starts the third week of every month.

There is no comprehensive examination for obtaining our High School diploma; you only need to get a score of 70% or higher in all our required courses.

Now that you have a High School diploma, then you have to take the PERT exam and pass it before you are admitted in Broward College of Tunisia, also known as the American University of Tunisia.

Based on your grades on the PERT sections, you will be assigned a class schedule that maximizes your learning performance and that allows you to complete your studies in a timely manner and achieve a higher GPA.

For all majors you choose, whether it is Engineering, Computing, Education, Science, or Business Administration, you still have to start with our 36 credits imposed by our General Education requirements in all our Associate degrees, AA, AS, or AAS.
